

CHURCH OFFICER QUALIFICATIONS

The Nominating Committee is in the process of discernment regarding the slate of nominees for membership on the Session, the Board of Deacons, and the Nominating Committee. You are invited to participate in this process by submitting names of individuals whom you feel are qualified to serve. You may nominate yourself as well.

Elders and Deacons take the same ordination vows as pastors with the exception of one specific, office-related question. All officers and Nominating Committee members-at-large are elected by the congregation

General qualifications for an officer include:

- membership on the roll of the church
- regular attendance at Sunday worship services
- regular participation in church activities
- commitment to the church and its vision, mission, and stewardship
- acting as a faithful witness to Christ in the areas of family, work, and community
- willingness to learn, openness to new ideas, and maturity of judgement

ELDERS

Elders serve on the Session, which is the ruling body of the church. The Session is responsible for the order of of church life, which includes worship, education, mission, and stewardship. Each elder will be assigned to a committee, and will also be expected to be a periodic representative at Presbytery meetings.

DEACONS

The office of Deacon is one of service, sympathy, and witness. Deacons minister to those who are in need within and outside the congregation. A Deacon participates in monthly board meetings and is involved with the ongoing work of the Board of Deacons.

NOMINATING COMMITTEE MEMBERS-AT-LARGE

The Nominating Committee is comprised of 7 people, 4 of which are considered members-at-large because they are not currently serving as officers.
